North Carolina Internist Dr. John D. Carr Joins Wellness Physician at Platt Medical Center in Palm Desert, CA

Platt Medical Center, founded by Board Certified Internist Dr. Michael E. He later became Chairman of the Department of Emergency Medicine at Cleveland Clinic Hospital in Ft. Lauderdale, FL, and subsequently established a private internal medicine practice in Charlotte, N.C.
